Dear all,

We would like to give you a report after the plea hearing held before the French Supreme Court on Tuesday March 14th 2023, opposing TÜV (more precisely TRLP and its French subsidiary TRF) to the victims of PIP's defective breast implants.

First, we would like to clarify that at this hearing, the Court has only considered our 1st appeal, which concerns 190 victims rejected by the decision issued by the Appeal Court of Versailles on January 14th 2021. The Court has not yet dealt with our 2nd appeal related to the inadmissible victims, neither with our 3rd appeal filed in early 2023 for 6 plaintiffs who were rejected by the Court of Appeal and who later announced their intention to appeal.

The aim of this organisation is to deal with all the appeals related to the issue of TÜV liability in one session. Indeed, at this hearing held on March 14th 2023, the Supreme Court examined our appeal as well as the appeals filed by TÜV against the judgments rendered by the Court of Appeal of Aix-en-Provence on February 11th 2021 and by the Court of Appeal of Paris on May 20th 2021, which granted the victims' claims and condemned TÜV to pay compensation.

In a second session, later in 2023 (we do not yet know the date), the French Supreme Court should consider the issue of inadmissible victims, i.e. patients who have been rejected by the Court of Appeal because the judges considered they did not provide enough evidence to prove they carry PIP's breast implants.

The outcome of the case will be known on May 25th 2023.

We remind you of the two possible outcomes of this procedure:

- either the Supreme Court overturns the Court of Appeal decision, and then:
 - (i) renders a final decision or
 - (ii) refers the case to a new Court of Appeal;
- either it rejects our claim and it's the end of the procedure.

We will of course keep you informed as soon as we receive the decision.
